5) Monitor > Evaluate > Modify Plan

Constant reassessment and tweaking are necessary to ensure best use of resources and efficient/effective CRR

Analyze interventions, efforts, and results. When applicable memorialize modifications in the plan including why, how, expected results and any new/ongoing performance indicators.
